

Declaration of Conflict-Free Minerals

Catcher Technology Co., Ltd (Catcher) is committed to supporting responsible sourcing of conflict minerals from affected countries. Therefore, we are committed to using conflict-free minerals. We also investigate our suppliers and require them to follow the Conflict-Free Minerals requirement. We grantee that any Minerals used in products sold to customers is "DRC Conflict-Free".

Catcher is taking and will take due diligence within our supply chain to assure the Minerals of gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), cobalt(Co) and tin (Sn) are not derived from or sourced from mines in conflict areas of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), or illegally taxed on trade routes, either of which are controlled by non-governmental military groups, or unlawful military factions. Trade routes not confirmed to be "Conflict Free" include direct exports from the DRC, as well as exports through Rwanda, Uganda, Burundi, Tanzania and Kenya (countries the U.N. Security Council note as global export routes for DRC-mined minerals).

Catcher hereby formulated this Conflict-Free Minerals Policy and makes following commitments:

- 1. Not to purchase conflict minerals from mines in the Conflict Regions.
- 2. Requiring its suppliers to refuse to use Conflict Minerals from the Conflict Regions and present a signed letter of commitment to Catcher.
- 3. Requiring its suppliers to manage their upstream and downstream suppliers, in order to follow the Conflict-Free Minerals requirement.
- 4. Making the best efforts to source conflict-free minerals from the DRC where possible, and agreeing to abide by the standard for EICC.
